Tree and Shrub Care

February is the perfect time to start pruning fruit trees. Timing is important to insure a productive harvest this summer.

* Mid February-late March. Begin with apples and pears, then peaches and apricots, followed by cherries. Start by cutting out all dead, diseased, or broken branches. Take out weak or less productive wood, and any crossing branches. Prune trees to shape.

* Mid February until buds break open. This is a good time to apply dormant oil spray to control overwintering insect pests.

* Early March. Most trees and shrubs can be pruned to clear winter damage and encourage summer growth.
